ANCHORING



How to keep yourself, your vessel and others safe



- Check your swing room is sufficient for the anchor scope (length of anchor warp) to ensure your boat doesn't drag or swing around and damage other craft.
- Ensure you have enough anchor line out to cover the tidal range and stream. Use at least three to five times the depth in calm conditions additional length will be necessary in higher winds.
- Choose an anchorage clear of busy channels, marina and bay entrances, and mooring fields.
- Check your chart for prohibited anchorages and avoid areas of underwater cables.
- Visibly display your contact name and phone number/email address in case of emergency.
