

WESTHAVEN MAST GANTRY

Westhaven Marina has a mast gantry, located at A pier, which can be booked by berth holders and non-tenants of Westhaven.

The mast gantry is provided so that vessel owners can remove a mast or small engine from a vessel. It has a load limit of 600kg.

HOW TO APPLY TO BOOK THE GANTRY

1. Complete this application form, with your name and contact details.
2. Choose your trained operator.
3. Make advance payment of the relevant fees.
4. Deliver the application form to the Marina office at least 24 hours before the requested booking date.

FEES FOR CUSTOMERS

A fixed fee of \$60 for Westhaven customers and \$120 for non-Westhaven customers is payable at the time of application.

A Westhaven customer is defined as a person who licences (or will licence) a berth within Westhaven Marina for more than 14 days immediately before or after the date on which the gantry is used.

INSURANCE

A valid certificate of currency evidencing that protection and indemnity insurance (for at least \$5 million per claim) is in place for the vessel, to cover third party loss, must be either held by or provided to the Marina office before the vessel is able to use the gantry.

APPROVED OPERATORS

Only trained operators are permitted to operate the Gantry, as listed below. The gantry cannot be operated by a Westhaven staff member.

MAST GANTRY APPLICATION

Gantry Use Terms and Conditions

- 1. Licence:** Panuku Development Auckland Limited as manager for Westhaven Marina Trust Limited agrees to licence the applicant named over (the "User") to use the Mast Gantry upon the following terms and conditions.
- 2. Usage:** The User agrees to use the Gantry for the sole purpose of:
 - Carrying out the removal/installation of the vessel's mast;
 - Carrying out the removal/installation of a small engine; or
 - Other works, subject to prior agreement with Westhaven Marina, and the User acknowledges and agrees that in conducting such works, the mast gantry must be operated by a trained gantry operator (and not the User).
- 3. Payment of fees for Westhaven and non-Westhaven berth holders.** The fee for each use of the gantry is \$60 for Westhaven customers and \$120 for non-Westhaven customers (see overleaf for definition of a Westhaven customer). The fee is to be paid prior to use.
- 4. Bookings:** The Marina Office will be open between the hours of 0730 and 1700 Monday to Thursday, and 0730 to 1630 Friday for all bookings, completion of application requirements, and payment.
- 5. Number of persons permitted around the gantry:** While the vessel is positioned on the Gantry not more than three persons (including the User and the trained operator) shall be permitted in the immediate area of the vessel and its surrounds. The User shall ensure that other persons comply with this condition.
- 6. Conditions for the use of the Gantry:**
 - Only the vessel named and described overleaf shall be permitted on the gantry during the period booked by the User.
 - The User shall ensure in conjunction with the gantry operator that the vessel shall be positioned and secured in position prior to commencement of work.
 - The User shall remain in attendance with the vessel whilst the gantry is in use.
 - The User shall not permit or allow any children under the age of 12 years to enter the Marina and the gantry area unless accompanied by an adult.
 - The User shall not engage in any swimming, diving or underwater activities within the Marina and shall ensure any other persons comply with this condition.
 - The User shall not discharge any contaminant or waste materials into the marina water or seabed.
 - The User shall abide by the rules and bylaws promulgated by Westhaven Marina from time to time, including but not limited to the requirements set out in the A-Z Guide.

- 7. Statutory Compliance:** In using the Gantry, the User shall comply with the requirements of the Resource Management Act 1991 and the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015. In particular, the User will comply with any health and safety direction from the trained operator and/or Marina, and will act in a manner that ensures their own safety and the safety of other persons.

The Marina will monitor the use of the gantry. Any User who does not comply with all relevant legislative requirements and any applicable management plan relevant to the gantry will not be permitted to use the gantry in the future.

- 8. Risks:** To the extent permitted by law, Westhaven Marina shall not be liable (in negligence or otherwise) and accepts no responsibility, for any loss or damage to the vessel or to any other property of the User or any third party, or for any injury, loss, or damage sustained or suffered by the User or any other person in the Marina, howsoever such injury, loss or damage may occur, and whether or not attributable to the acts or defaults of Westhaven Marina or its servants, agents, contractors or otherwise howsoever. The Marina makes no representations or warranties as to the adequacy or otherwise of the Marina, or the Gantry, or any other part of the facilities of the Marina.
- 9. Insurance:** The User shall at all times maintain protection and indemnity insurance (to cover any third party loss caused by the User or the vessel) for at least \$5,000,000 per event or claim. The Marina also recommends that the User maintain marine hull insurance (to cover any loss or damage to the Vessel), and insurance for any other property owned or brought on to the Marina by the User and/or invitees of the User. The User shall provide a detailed certificate of currency evidencing such insurance to the Marina office.
- 10. Acceptance:** Westhaven Marina reserves the right to accept or decline an application for use of the Gantry (in its sole discretion).
- 11. User terms:** For completeness, the User acknowledges that the trained operator selected by the User to operate the gantry is also required to sign certain terms and conditions, and comply with operating instructions, issued by the Marina.
